Time and Location

July 30—August 12, 2025 Beijing, China



Activities

Chinese language learning and practice, Chinese cultural lectures and hands-on experiences, visits to places of interest, art appreciation, cultural exchanges, get-togethers between Chinese and international students, and more.



Concept

- Tiered Chinese Language Teaching: Offer courses designed for different proficiency levels to help learners gain a deeper understanding of Chinese language and culture.
- Multicultural Exchange Activities: Facilitate cultural integration and interaction among participants from various countries through non-verbal activities.
- Classic Beijing Cultural Experience: Organize immersive tours to explore Beijing's rich historical heritage and modern development.

Life Management

- One chaperon and one language assistant per team for daily life arrangements
- Full-time security personnel and dormitory supervisors for campsite safety
- Meals in compliance with national food safety standards
- Bus transportation with accompanying tour guides, school doctors, and staff members





Scale

Estimated 150 participants (including chaperons)



Language

Chinese and English, with additional language services available in Spanish, German, Bulgarian, Korean, Hungarian, Italian, etc.



Expenditure

The program will cover the expenses for participants and chaperons during their stay in Beijing, including accommodation, transportation (with group airport pick-up and drop-off services on registration and departure days), course learning, cultural tours, and insurance (only travel accident insurance within China; participants are strongly advised to purchase international travel insurance covering the entire trip in their home country).

Qualifications

- Qualifications for camp students: basic physical and mental fitness for participating in overseas summer camps; abiding by disciplines and rules of the summer camp; signing the summer camp participation statement; undergraduates, postgraduates, and doctoral students from recognized overseas public and private universities or related educational institutions who have passed HSK1/YCT3 or above examination; aged between 18 and 30 years old, of non-Chinese nationality, and whose native language is not Chinese; having not participated in the "Chinese Bridge" offline summer camp for foreign students within three years; good health, suitable for international travel.
- Qualifications for chaperons: a passion for education, affinity, a sense of responsibility, strong communication skills, and adaptability to new environments; in good health, suitable for international travel; experienced in student management and leading overseas study tours; proactive and responsible, committed to staying within the camp unless granted permission to leave; signing the summer camp participation statement; proficient in both Chinese and the native language of the team; able to keep contact with the BFSU program team via WeChat; responsible for organizing and rehearsing performances or activities for the team.
- Selection: each Confucius Institute (CI) will conduct interviews to select and recommend 15-30 students and 1-2 chaperons.
- Preparation: each CI team is encouraged to prepare 1-2 performances for the Closing Ceremony Get-together. (Costumes and props needed in all activities shall be prepared by the team members themselves, and please make sure to inform the project team in writing at least one month in advance of any special requirements.)

● 参与方式

- **营员条件**:有参加海外夏令营的基本身体和心理条件,遵守项目纪律规定,签署参营声明;境外正规公立或私立学校、相关教育机构在读大学生、硕士生及博士生,须通过HSK1级/YCT3级以上考试;年龄18-30周岁,非中国国籍,母语非汉语;三年内未参加过"汉语桥"外国学生线下夏令营项目;身体健康,适合国际旅行。
- 教师条件: 热爱教育事业,有亲和力、责任心,沟通能力、环境适应能力强;身体健康,适合国际旅行;具有丰富的学生管理经验和海外游学带团经验;积极负责、不擅自离营,签署参营声明;熟练掌握中文及小队语言,可以使用微信与项目组联络,负责小队节目/活动的编排、组织工作。
- 选拔方式: 各孔院面试、选拔、推荐15—30名营员,1—2名带队教师。
- **准备工作**:鼓励各孔院小队准备1—2个文艺节目参加闭营仪式联欢。 (服装道具需由各队自行准备,如有特殊要求需项目支持务必提前1个月书面告知项目组)
