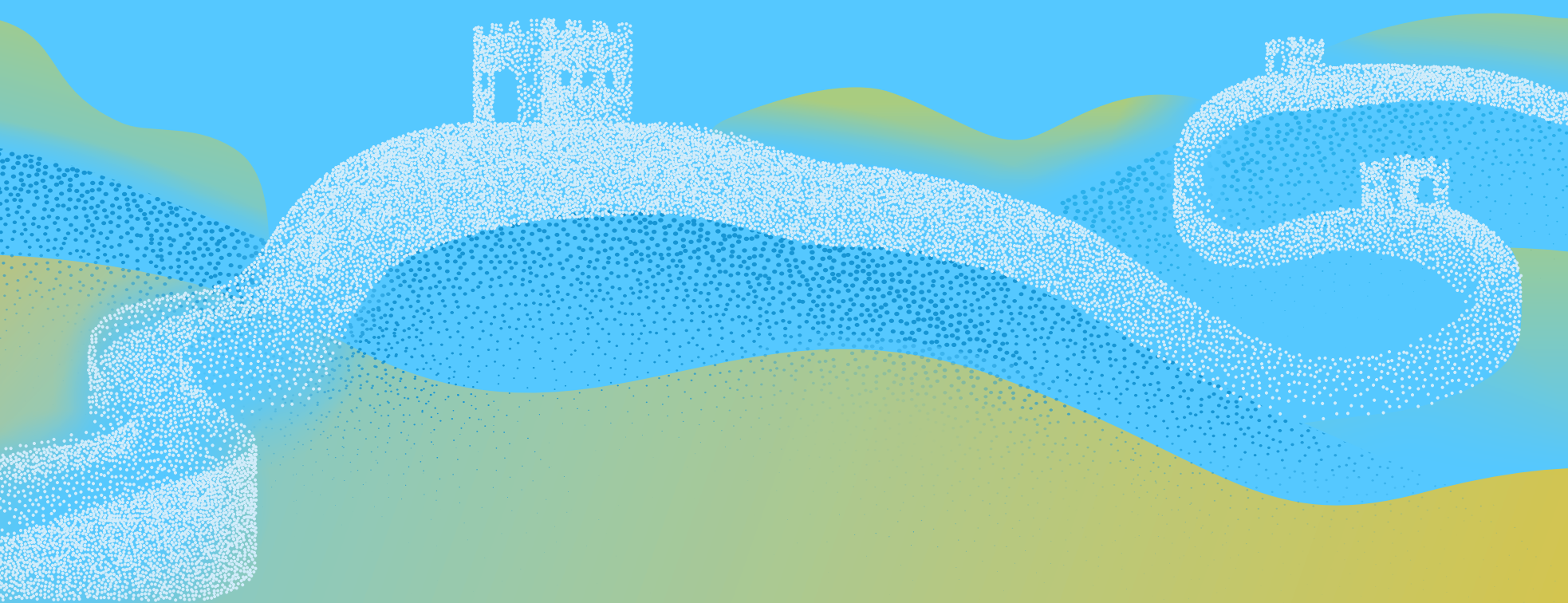

Cost Coverage

The program will cover the expenses for participants and chaperones during their stay in Beijing, including accommodation, transportation (with group airport pick-up and drop-off on registration and departure days), course learning, cultural tours, and insurance (travel accident insurance within China only). Participants are advised to purchase international travel insurance covering the entire trip in their home country prior to departure).



Eligibility

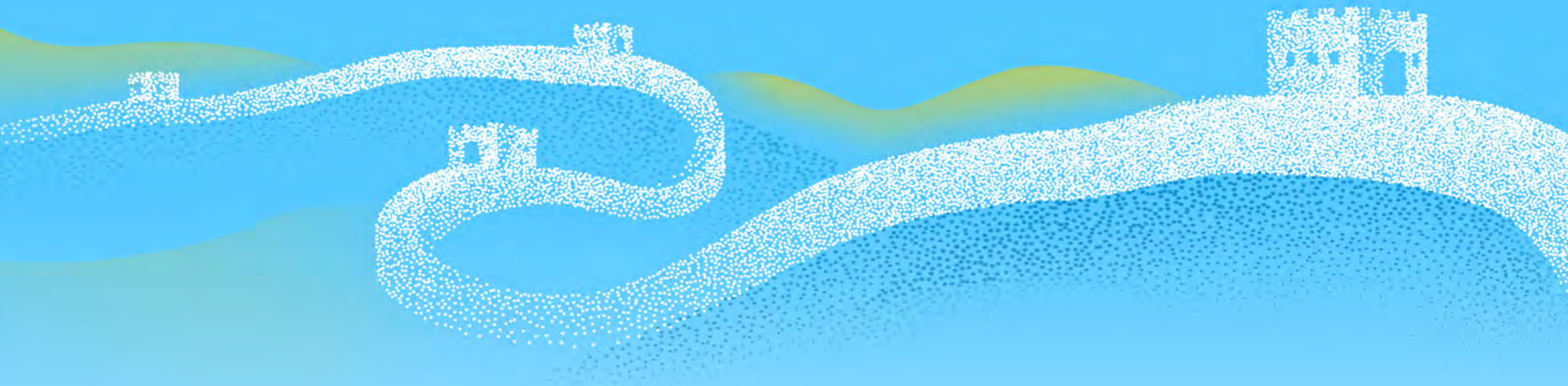
For Campers

- Physically and mentally fit to participate in an overseas summer camp
- Able to abide by program regulations and sign the participation statement
- Currently enrolled undergraduate, postgraduate, or doctoral students at recognized public or private overseas universities or related educational institutions
- **Have passed HSK Level 1 or YCT Level 3 or above**
- Aged between 18 and 30, of non-Chinese nationality, with a native language other than Chinese
- **Have not participated in a “Chinese Bridge” offline summer camp for international students within the past three years**
- In good health and fit for international travel

📍 For Chaperones

- Passion for education, strong affinity, sense of responsibility, excellent communication skills, and adaptability to new environments
- In good health and fit for international travel
- Experienced in student management and leading overseas study tours
- Proactive and responsible, committed to staying within the camp unless granted special permission, and willing to sign the participation statement
- Proficient in both Chinese and the team's working language, able to stay in contact with the program team via WeChat
- Responsible for organizing and rehearsing team performances or activities

📍 **Selection:** Each Confucius Institute (CI) shall conduct interviews, screen, and recommend campers and chaperons in accordance with the enrollment quota for the Summer Camp.

📍 **Preparation:** Each CI team is encouraged to prepare 1—2 performances for the Closing Ceremony Get-together.

(Costumes and props are to be prepared by the teams themselves. Please inform the program team of any special requirements in writing at least one month in advance.)
